ISI World's Competition Travel Team 2026

MISSION: to provide meaningful opportunities for skaters to grow both as athletes and as individuals through team travel experience. We choose this ISI Worlds Team Competition event because it provides the greatest opportunities for all skaters of all ages and levels to compete together towards a common collective.

The **“WHY” ISI/Worlds Team:** Outside of synchronized skating, no other team experience in recreational figure skating exists.

GOAL: the goal of this competition is to compile a team total equivalent to 440 points.

HOW: see Coach Matt's “Path to 440” breakdown

TRAVEL COST per skater: \$150

- \$125. This is Coach Matt's fee. No additional costs will be due for travel expenses, food/lodging, etc. or for time worked at competition.
- \$25. Props travel trailer

COMPETITION COST(s): \$115 (first event) plus \$40 per each additional event

OPTIONAL cost(s):

- Pins: quantities of 10, 20 or 30 (price TBD, depending on total quantity ordered)
- Nike Junior Academy Pro 24 Sideline Fill Jackets (bulk pricing = TBD)
- Backpacks (approx. \$75, including personalization)

 - Order jackets & arrange for personalization
 - Distribute

 - Final submission date: 5/15/26
